

<b>Step by step guide to entering our competition</b>	Tick: ✓
Decide which picture(s) you like and have them framed, do not use clip frames!	
Fit 'D' rings to the moulding on the back and put a string across so that we can hang the picture. Tip: Liteglaze etc. is safer than glass and won't break in the post.	
Fill in our entry form and stick one form to the back of each picture with Cellotape, if it's too big fold it up and put it in an envelope and stick the envelope down with Cellotape.	
Write out a cheque for £10 for <b>each picture</b> (four pictures = £40.00) and stick it on the back of each picture with the entry form; cheques should be made out to 'The Hoffmann Foundation for Autism', add 10% for commission.	
Wrap your picture(s) up very carefully in bubble wrap, cardboard and brown paper.	
Send the picture(s) by post or bring them yourself to this address:

<p><b>Rules of the Competition</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <i>There is no pre-selection and no age limit.</i></li> <li>2. <i>A commission of 10% will be taken from the sale price of your picture, so decide what you want to sell it for and then add 10%!</i></li> <li>3. <i>All work must be framed; clip frames are dangerous and will not be accepted.</i></li> <li>4. <i>For hanging, 'D' rings and string must be fixed to the back of the picture.</i></li> <li>5. <i>Work must be of a reasonable size.</i></li> <li>6. <i>Work can be sent by post or brought to the Day Service by hand.</i></li> <li>7. <i>We do not accept liability for loss or damage to work in transit or on our premises. Please explore your own insurance options.</i></li> <li>8. <i>Work must be submitted on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2011.</i></li> <li>9. <i>Work can be in any media but 3D work can't be displayed so please don't send any.</i></li> <li>10. <i>Prizes are awarded at the judge's discretion.</i></li> <li>11. <i>The judge's decision is final.</i></li> </ol>
